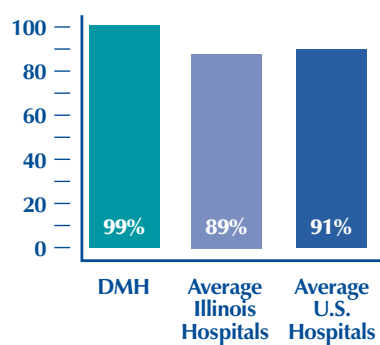
Measuring Our Performance

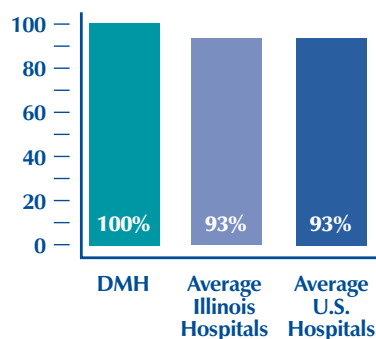
Surgical Infection Prevention Measures

Percent of patients who were given an antibiotic within one hour before surgery to help prevent infection:*



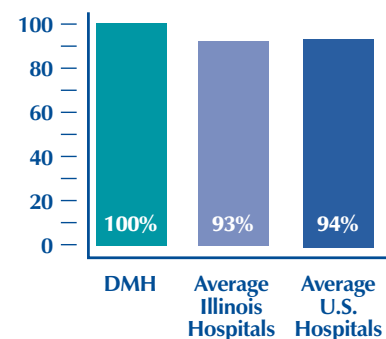
Heart Attack Measures

Percent of heart attack patients given aspirin at discharge:*



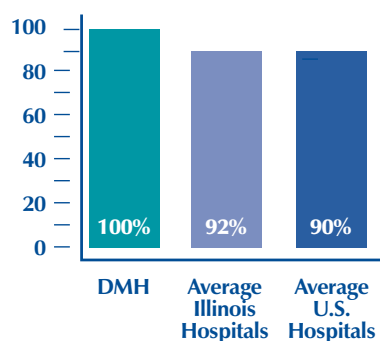
Heart Attack Measures

Percent of heart attack patients given beta blocker at discharge:*



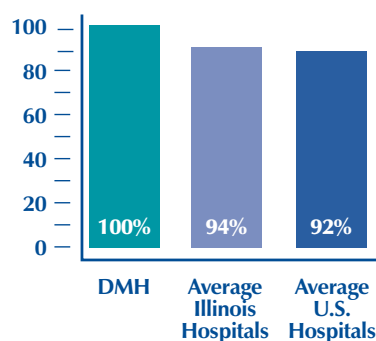
Pneumonia Measures

Percent of pneumonia patients given smoking cessation advice and counseling:*



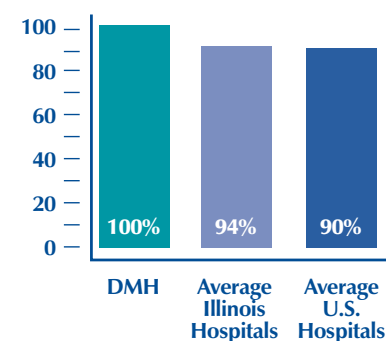
Heart Failure Measures
